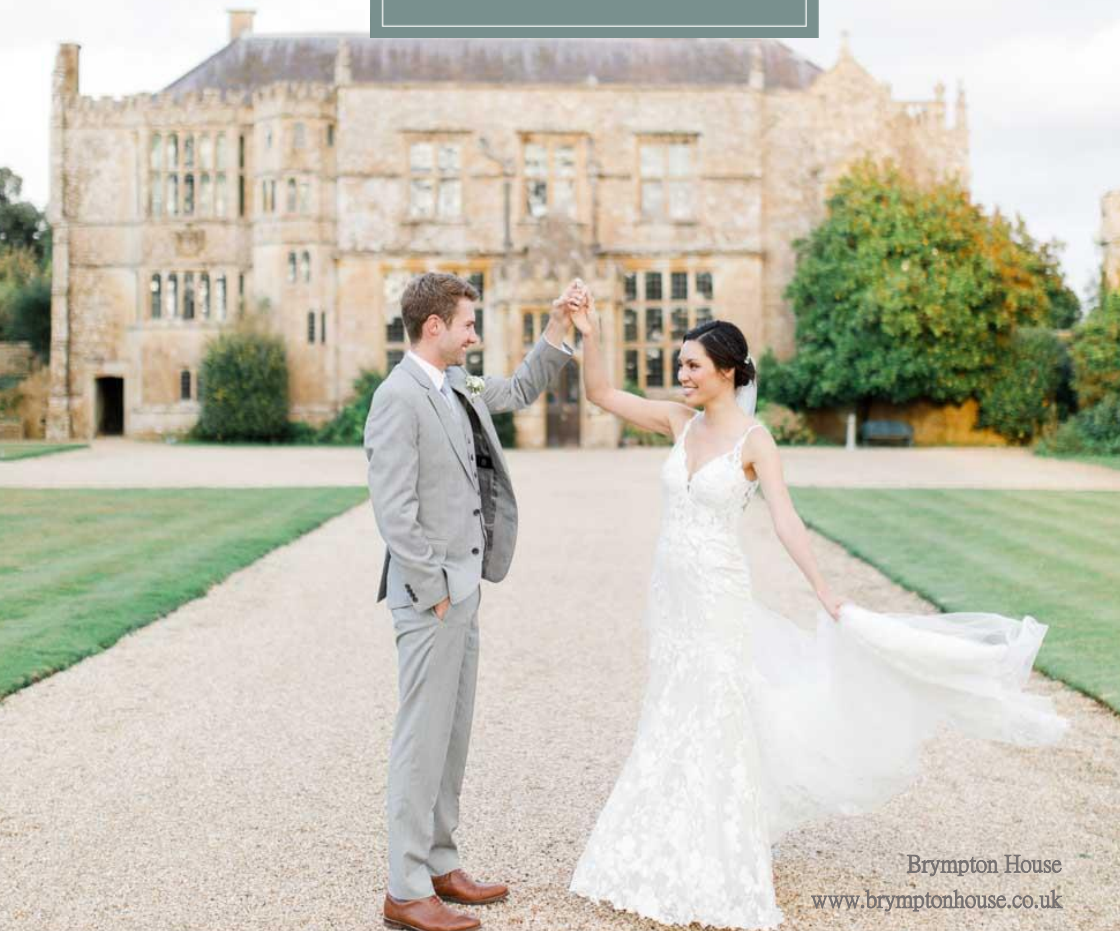

BIJOU wedding Booking Terms & Conditions

In addition to the general Terms & Conditions, the following addendum shall apply:

Payment Terms

A non-refundable payment of £1,500.00 is required to secure the booking and is part of the confirmation. The remaining balance will be payable 12 weeks prior to the event.

Agreed Booking Terms Fees are determined on the basis of the use of The Barn for the period of time set

out below. Inclusive wedding package agreed booking period: four (6) hours total. Please allow sufficient time for your guests to arrive pre-ceremony. Up to two (2) hours additional hire time may be arranged for a fee. Please refer to the main brochure for full wedding day pricing.

Registrars

Castle House and The Temple are licensed for civil ceremonies. Use of this licence, furniture and set up for your ceremony is included but you have legal responsibility to

book your registrars. Please contact Somerset County Council on 01823 282251.

Bar & Alcohol

We do not permit you to provide your own drinks at any point.

Food & Catering

All food must be provided by our caterers. You are not permitted to provide any other or additional food.
