## *saying i do*

At Brympton House we understand how important it is to create an entirely bespoke and personal wedding.

Civil ceremonies at Brympton take place in the romantic Castle House, a medieval building adjacent to the main house. Dating back to 1350 and with an elegant long aisle leading up to a beautiful arched mullion window, Castle House has an air of reverence, particularly when adorned with fresh flowers and candles. Centrally heated, this is a perfect ceremony venue throughout the year. Double doors at the back of the building allow guests to exit out on to the stunning South Terrace for a drinks reception overlooking the lake.

If you like the idea of getting married in the great outdoors, The Temple is also licensed for civil ceremonies. This imposing 18th century structure was once the entrance to Frome Town Hall and has been on the South Terrace at Brympton House since the 1930's.

Tie the knot under the pretty façade whilst guests sit on wooden pews on the terrace. With the house on one side and the stunning grounds and lake on the other, there can be no finer setting for a romantic outdoor ceremony.

The beautiful candlelit St. Andrews Church dates from the 13th Century and can be found in the grounds of Brympton House. St. Andrews is a remarkable church and is on the list of Top 100 Prettiest Churches in the UK! Home to a fully functioning organ as well as having ample space for a choir or string quartet, there are plenty of options for entrance and exit music. You are welcome to hold your full religious ceremony within the Church or instead can have a blessing of marriage.

## *greeting guests*

Following your ceremony there's time for your guests to enjoy canapés and drinks whilst you have your 'sweetheart shots' taken for the photograph album.

You have a choice as to where to host your drinks reception at Brympton House. Popular choices include the elegant South Terrace, which sits beside the stunning lake, or the Elizabethan Great Hall.

With the house on one side and the stunning lake on the other, the South Terrace is a wonderful location for a Spring, Summer or Autumn drinks reception. The Terrace is furnished with garden tables and chairs and overlooks the croquet lawn. Guests can enjoy a variety of garden games including croquet, giant connect four and even space hoppers!

If the weather is inclement, you can host your drinks reception in the magnificent Elizabethan Great Hall. This imposing entrance hall, with its flagstone floors, Elizabethan wainscoting and impressive open fire, gives you the opportunity to greet your guests in regal style. A baby grand piano can be played and there is ample space for musicians, from harpists to string quartets.



## *your dining and drinking experience*

At Brympton House we have a wonderful selection of hand-picked suppliers who can cater for your every need, from afternoon tea on the lawn, to a fine dining wedding breakfast and all-inclusive drinks packages to bespoke cocktails. Alternatively, you can bring in your own catering and alcohol.

On the day of your wedding, the Library Bar can serve pre-ceremony drinks to your guests, while a selection of canapés and cocktails are offered post-ceremony. For your wedding breakfast, invite guests to dine in one of many spectacular rooms at Brympton House.

The Ballroom is reached from the candlelit Grand Staircase Hall, which holds the longest continuous wooden staircase in the U.K. Dating back to 1640 and flooded with natural light, it seats up to 200 guests. The ultimate in elegance, the Ballroom's neutral décor makes it a blank canvas for any colour scheme.

The State Apartments include both the Grand Saloon and The State Dining Room, perfect for more intimate occasions. The Grand Saloon seats up to 100 for dinner and features a stylish baroque fireplace. With windows overlooking the terrace, it makes an idyllic Summer dining room while the addition of the open fire and candlelight offers warmth to a sumptuous Winter wedding.

The silk-lined State Dining Room is not to be missed. A wonderfully atmospheric space adorned in shades of deep red, it seats up to 50 people for dinner. With an absence of overhead electric lights, the candle chandelier provides a romantic glow. The State Dining Room is also suggested as the perfect area in which to enjoy a pre-wedding dinner the night before your big day. Alternatively, a more relaxed supper can be enjoyed in the Star Chamber, the original medieval kitchen.

For the evening celebration, we invite you to dance the night away in The Party Barn which has been cleverly converted into your evening party suite. Three adjoining spaces offer a fully stocked marble-topped bar, chill out area and dance floor, adorned with fairy lights. Enjoy a hog roast or barbecue on the courtyard while gazing over the beautiful house and enjoying fireworks as a grand finale to your magical day.

## *your evening party*

The magnificent Party Barn at Brympton House was made for celebrating and hosting a cracking party!

It provides the perfect spot to let your hair down and dance the night away with friends and family. The barn - which dates from 1710 - is based in the former carriage house and stables and has a rustic vibe.

The courtyard is, arguably, one of the most beautiful spots on the estate as it looks back across the estate and also holds an impressive fire pit - perfect for roasting marshmallows on!

The set up within the barn is perfectly designed for an incredible party - you have a choice between two incredible sprung dance floors, a marble topped well-stocked bar as well as a comfy room, which is ideal for catching up with guests and taking a moment to relax!

You can party till late in the Barn with celebrations able to go on until 3am. When your band goes home the celebrations do not need to end as you and your guests can go on to enjoy a nightcap in the Library Bar in front of a roaring fire.

All of these spaces open out onto the central cobbled courtyard which is lit by a fairy light canopy.

With 31 beautiful bedrooms across the Estate, you can relax in the knowledge that you don't have to leave your wedding venue at the end of a magical day and can stay on a little longer should you wish!

There are 31 bedrooms across the estate, sleeping 72 guests, so ample room for your close family and friends to spend the night. Elegantly furnished, with white linens and roll top baths or waterfall showers, they offer you and your guests a luxurious stay.

Amongst the bedrooms there are family bedrooms, ground floor disabled bedrooms as well as two pet friendly bedrooms for those that want to bring their fluffy family members!

In addition to the bespoke bedrooms, there are 100 stunning bell tents available within the beautiful grounds. Sleeping under canvas is a real treat and your guests will not be disappointed! The beauty of canvas tents is that it keeps you cooler in hot weather and warmer in cold weather, and with a hot chocolate & water bottle service available for colder months, the Glamping tents are a great option for all year round.

The Honeymoon suite at Brympton is wonderfully romantic.
